



WESTSIDE UNITED SELECT SOCCER PROGRAM Player Registration Instructions



Step 1: Go to Ballard Youth Soccer Club Web Site.

Go to Ballard Youth Soccer Club registration web site (<http://www.ballardsoccer.org/sam/registration>). Click on '2009 Select Soccer' hyperlink to enter player registration.

Step 2: Member Log In.

If you do not already have a member account (which is likely if you are either not a returning Westside United player or are not from Ballard), click on "No, I do not have a member account". Else, click on "Yes, I already have a member account" and log in (skip the next instruction).

The next page requests that you select a Registration Category (i.e. U-11 Boys). Select an age-gender that your child will be playing in and click 'NEXT'.

Note to U11 "Play Ups": If your player is a "play up" for U11 (U10 playing at U11), you may be required to select U10 based on his/her birthdate. The program will move the player to the appropriate team).

Parent and Player Code of Conduct Agreement

Please don't mail into the club. Give to your coach.

Parents, players, and coaches are required to follow the association's code of conduct. Players or parents who violate these rules may be disciplined at the game (told to leave) and/or required to appear before the SYSA Judicial Board. Violations may result in a variety of consequences, including player suspension and parental bans. Coaches are responsible for their players and for controlling their sidelines. Disruptive parents who do not follow their coach's instructions may cause the coach to be red-carded, the game forfeited, or the game abandoned by the referee.

Code of Conduct for Players

1. Learn and observe the Law of Soccer and league rules.
2. Treat other players as you wish to be treated—do not abuse or ridicule other players, officials, coaches, or spectators. Control your play and discipline yourself. Do not play wildly and jeopardize your safety or that of other players. Hold your temper and control your anger. Play clean and fair. Use your skill and talent. Don't cheat.
3. Listen to your coaches and accept their advice with respect.
4. Respect referees and lines people—do not question their decisions.
5. Give the ball promptly to your opponent for their throw-ins, free kicks, etc. Do not stall by withholding the ball or encroaching on free kicks.
6. Win with grace and lose with dignity. You, your club, and your association will be judged by your behavior.

Code of Conduct for Parents

1. Always be supportive of your child, their teammates, and the coaches. Remember that every player on the team is a contributing player. Spread your encouragement equitably amongst the team.
2. Never badger the opposition nor argue with their supporters. Be appreciative of good play from both sides.
3. Never harass or badger the referees or the lines people.
4. After each match, have a positive attitude and show an appreciation for the innocence of your child's effort.



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Step 8: Review and Accept the Medical Release Waiver.

Review the Medical Release Waiver. **PRINT A COPY A SUPPLIED SIGNED TO YOUR COACH.**

Check the acknowledgement box at the bottom and click on the 'NEXT' button to continue.



Step 9: Review Registration Summary.

Review the Participant Registration Summary information. Click on the 'CONTINUE' button beside 'I'm ready to finish registration now'.



Step 8: Process Registration.

Review the Registration Payment Summary and then click on the 'Next' button.

Enter information to complete your payment by debit/credit card and hit 'Finish'

Upon success processing, the Registration Receipt will be displayed. Print out Registration Receipt for your records by clicking on the 'Print your receipt' at the bottom left of the page.

You will receive an email confirming registration of your player.
